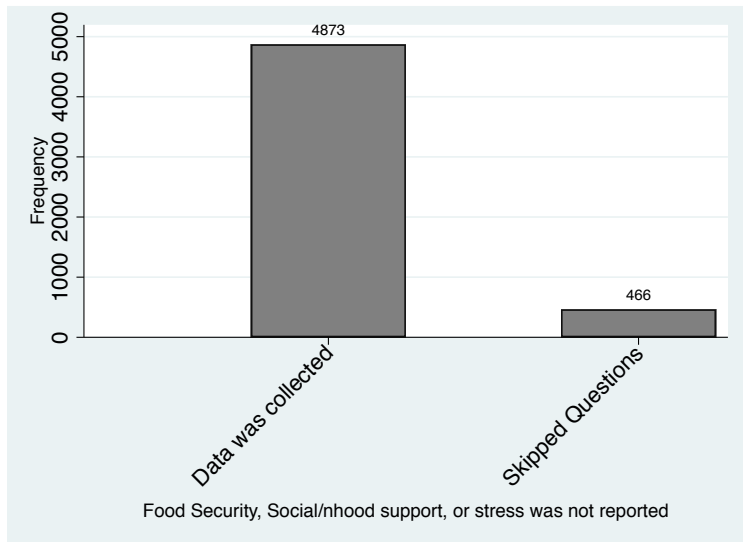

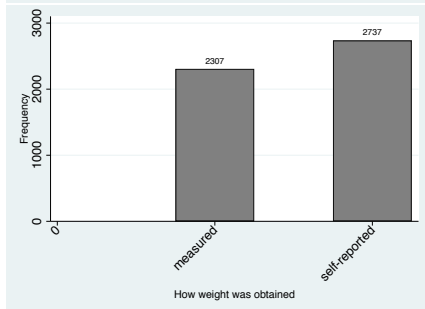
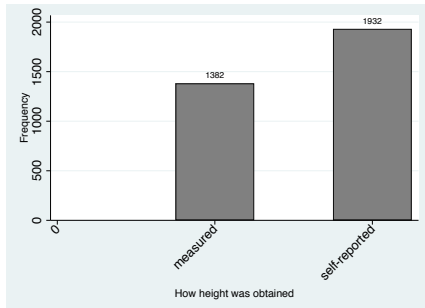

# How often are questions not being asked?

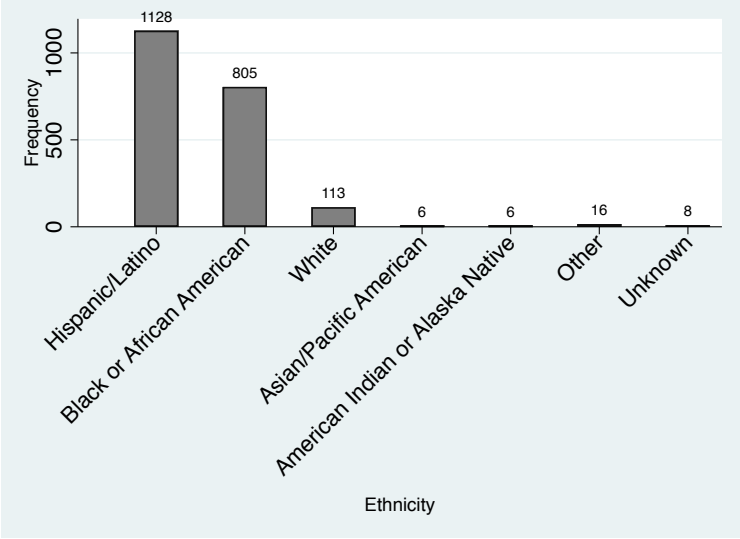


# How often is weight (or height for new clients) not being measured?

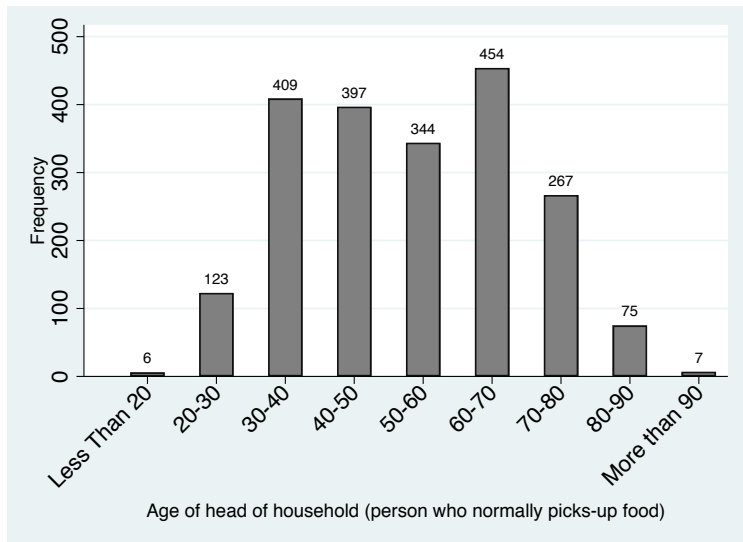

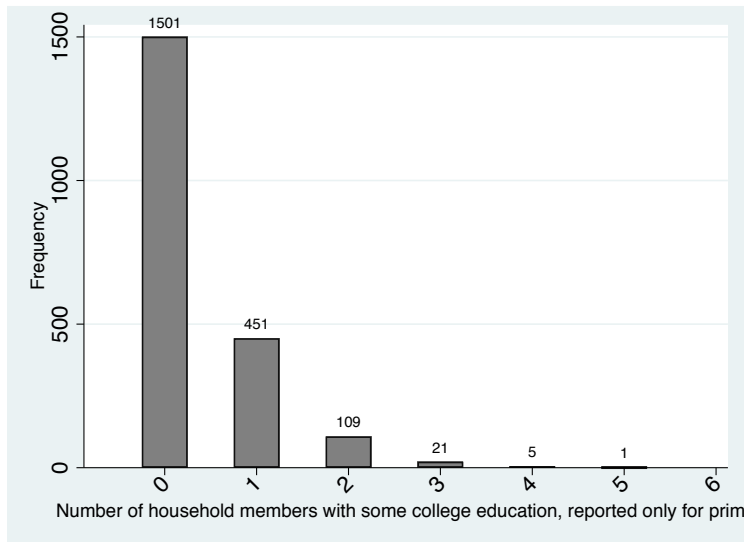
# Head Educational Attainment



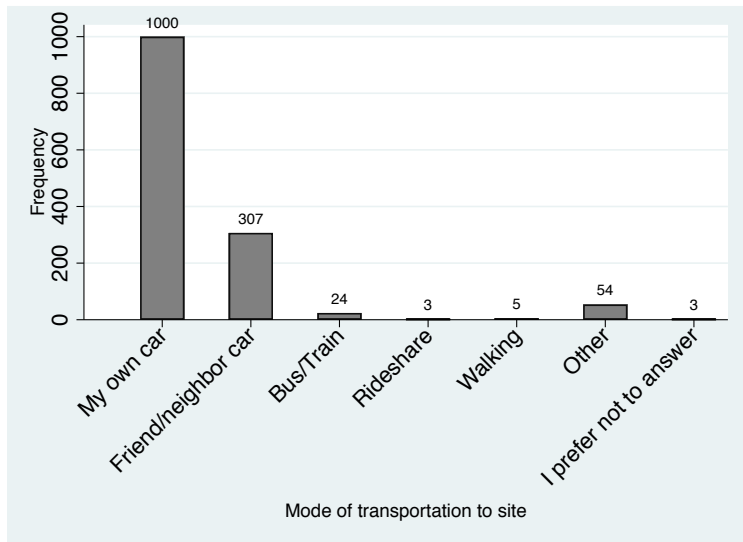
# Household Educational Attainment through High School



# Household Educational Attainment Beyond High School



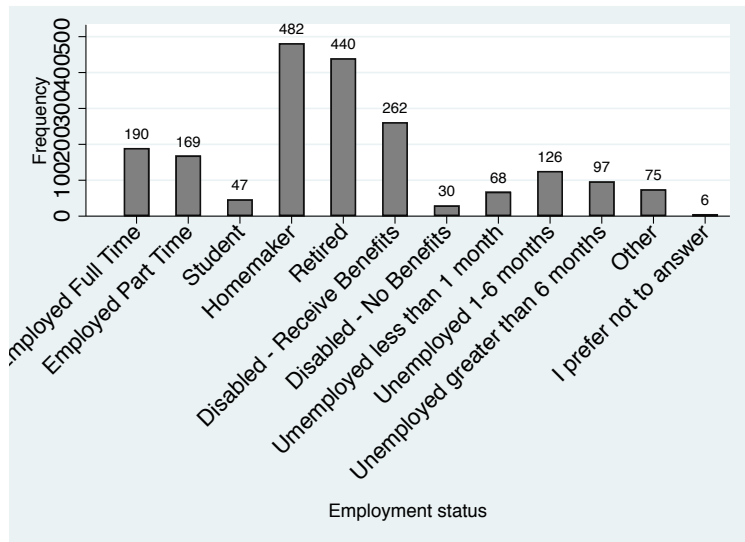

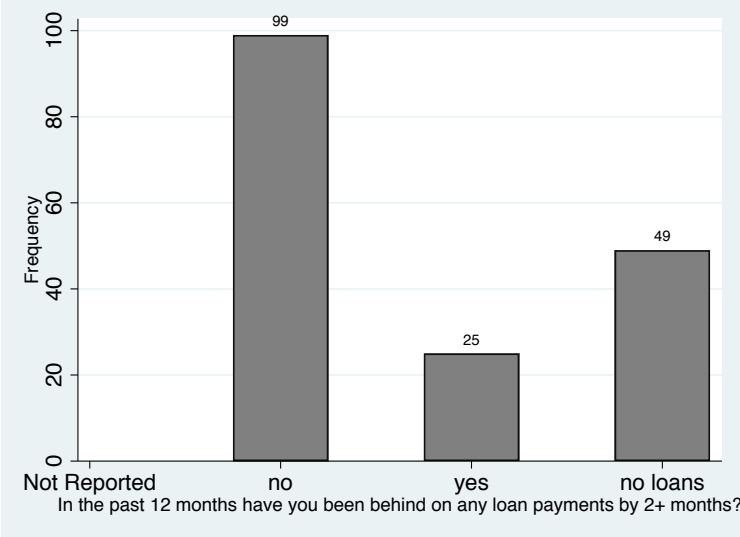
