THE FINANCIAL AID PROCESS

1. Submit your FAFSA. Available now. (Opened October 1)
2. You will be notified by email when your financial aid is available online. *Confirm your preferred email address on BANNERWEB:*

3. Sign in to BANNERWEB to review your aid. Complete additional paperwork as required.

- **Book vouchers and emergency advances** are available from Student Account Services for students anticipating a refund.
- Refunds of excess financial aid will be released **within 14 days after** the disbursement of funds.

Financial aid recipients must be enrolled in a **degree-seeking program** and enroll at minimum **half-time status** (at least 4.5 credits) **towards degree**. You must be meeting Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) requirements.

* **Receiving aid from other sources** may require an adjustment to the award package. *

* **Dropping hours during the refund period or withdrawing** will affect financial aid.

Contact Financial Aid in the case of a withdrawal as a withdrawal from the University through the 60% point of the term is subject to a return of funds calculation, which may cause a balance owed to the University. It is your responsibility to read through the [Return of Funds Policy](#) and to check with your Financial Aid Counselor on how a withdrawal will affect you prior to withdrawing.
