--Guests must be of the same sex as the hosting resident and roommate (except fathers under specific circumstances),

--Guests must be over the age of 16,

--Hosts will be held responsible for any and all guest behavior that violates University of Dallas Community Standards or Residence Life policy,

--The host's roommate must consent to having a guest. This means that the host must have approval from both their roommate(s) and their Resident Assistant.

For any extenuating circumstances, resident must speak to Residence Coordinator to get approval. This approval for a guest staying overnight will not be approved unless it has the roommate's and the RA's signature.
