JOB DESCRIPTION

The Department of Philosophy, University of Dallas, invites applications for a Tenure-track, Assistant Professor, beginning Fall semester, 2022. AOS: Open, with some preference for Plato or later Medieval. AOC: History of Western Philosophy. Ph.D. required prior to appointment. Teaching load: 3/3.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

A candidate should satisfy the following three requirements: (1) The candidate shares our commitment to the recovery and renewal of the Western heritage of liberal education and the Catholic intellectual tradition. (2) The candidate is adequately prepared to teach in our B.A., M.A., and Ph.D. programs, and in the philosophy portion of the undergraduate core curriculum. (3) The candidate articulates how his or her research interests contribute to the search for philosophic wisdom.

APPLICATION

Applications must include (1) a letter of application that addresses the above requirements, (2) a curriculum vitae, (3) three confidential letters of recommendation, and (4) a writing sample not to exceed 25 pages.
