EARLY REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS for current students. Rome Registration: Instructions at the Rome Meeting, Monday, November 5, 6:30 p.m., Gorman Lecture Center A. **Early Registration for undergraduate students ends on Friday, December 14.** Web registration will re-open January 7th.

Registration for each group except Seniors opens at 12:01 a.m. CST and is based on the number of credits completed through Fall 2018:

Seniors (90+ credits):	November 5, 2018 – Registration opens at 9:00 a.m.
Juniors (60-89 credits):	November 7, 2018
Sophomores (30-59 credits):	November 9, 2018
Freshmen (less than 30 credits):	November 12, 2018
Special Undergrads – Non-degree seeking:	November 16, 2018

Graduate students in Braniff & the Neuhoff School of Ministry: Braniff students must submit an advising form for approval before the registration hold will be removed. Graduate online registration is open through December 14 and does not require an alt pin; it will re-open on January 7th.

PhD Students:	November 5, 2018 – Registration opens at 9:00 a.m.
All Master's Level Students:	November 6, 2018
Special Graduate Students:	November 16, 2018

Web-Assisted Registration in the Registrar's Office – Cardinal Farrell Hall, Suite 180: November 12-December 13 & January 7-30.

Wednesday evenings, November 7-December 12 and January 7-30, someone will be in the Registrar's Office until 7:00 p.m. to assist with registration. **NOTE: University offices closed for Thanksgiving, November 21-23.**

CLASSES BEGIN: Wednesday, January 23 (Graduate College of Business courses begin January 22)

Before Registration check the schedule via Banner Web, or pick up the schedule booklet in the Office of the Registrar.

1. Your advising transcript is available via Banner Web. Use the course planning sheet to make a list of your proposed courses.
2. **Meet with your advisor** for schedule approval before registration. Undergraduate students will need their alternate PIN in order to register. If your advisor is not available, you may try to schedule an appointment with the department chair for your major.
3. **Check Banner Web to view holds.** **Business Office clearance** is required for early registration. Check for any holds from other offices, including: **Financial Aid; Library; Student Life; Registrar.**
4. **Seniors: Verify your intent to Graduate by enrolling in one of the following courses, depending on your expected date of graduation:**
VVV-V0ZX-1VS Verify Intent to Graduate-Spring 2019 (CRN 10740); VVV-V0ZX-1VU Verify Intent to Graduate-Summer 2019 (CRN 10741); VVV-V0ZX-1VF Verify Intent to Graduate-Fall 2019 (CRN 10742).
 - o Our office will do a degree audit on each student, beginning with each expected graduation term in sequence. We will first audit Spring 2019 potential graduates, followed by Summer and Fall. We want to avoid surprises for both students and parents, making sure all degree requirements will be met:
 - Core Requirements
 - Major Requirements
 - Advanced Credits (38 minimum)
 - Minimum GPA requirement
 - Total credits required for the degree
 - Minor or Concentration requirements (if applicable)
 - Possible honors at graduation (including all transfer credit grades)
 - Once each student has been evaluated, they are moved to the appropriate "Graduation List Confirmed" course – VVV-V0ZZ-1VS (Spring 2019), VVV-V0ZZ-1VU (Summer 2019), or VVV-V0ZZ-1VF (Fall 2019). The class rosters are used to keep track of graduating students for commencement and conferral of degrees.
5. **Note:** Any student who is registered by the Registrar's Office will need to drop the placeholder verification course – VVV-V000-1VE via Banner Web. If you registered online you will not be enrolled in the placeholder course. Courses that require registration by our staff would be: graduate or doctoral readings, internships, research, or independent studies. To **audit** a course, you will need to be enrolled by the Registrar's Office starting January 22nd if seats are still available in the class. Classes can be changed to audit up to February 26th.

NEW STUDENT REGISTRATION: Tuesday, January 22, 9:00-11:30 a.m. and 1:00-4:30 p.m.

LATE REGISTRATION: A late fee of \$100 applies for **continuing** students who enroll after January 23rd.

Online Registration Instructions – Spring 2019

I. Before registration begins:

- Check your contact information. Choose “Personal Information” on main menu and update your addresses, phone numbers, and email addresses. You can change your “preferred” email address by completing the form in the Registrar’s Office. All official email notices will still be sent to your UD email address. If you use a private account, forward your UD mail to an account that you check on a daily basis. Call the AIS office for help (972-721-4137, or email bweathe@udallas.edu).
- If you are receiving emails from the University of Dallas directed to “Class of 2019” for example, please let our office know if you should be on a different email list. We want to make sure you receive the correct communications for your expected date of graduation.
- Check your registration status, including your advisor and holds. From the main menu, go to Students – Registration – Check your Registration Status. Click the “View Holds” link for holds.
- Look up Classes: Before registration begins, use this link to view the schedule of classes. From the main menu: Students – Registration – Look up Classes to Add.
- Choose the term from the drop-down menu and click Submit;
- Choose a subject from the menu, click Course Search, and choose a course to see section details. **OR**
- Choose **Advanced Search**, select a subject, and click Section Search to see all course sections on the same screen, with time, instructor, and capacity.
- To see the entire schedule, choose **Advanced Search**. Holding the shift button down, highlight all of the subjects with a number 1- in front of the subject, then search. “NR” or “SR” next to the course number = you cannot register for the section yet; “C” indicates the section is closed. “CAP” = Capacity; “ACT” = Actual Enrollment – seats already taken; “REM” = Seats Remaining.
- If there is an “R” in the section number, this class meets at the Rome Campus and not in Irving, so if you intend to be here on Campus, you do not want to choose a Rome Campus section.
- Explanation of Course Numbering System: Courses numbered below 3000 are freshman-sophomore courses; 5000 indicates senior-graduate level; courses numbered 6000 and above are graduate-level courses. If a course is cross-listed with both 3000/5000 or 5000/6000, make sure you enroll in the correct section for your level.

II. Registration Process and Search Functions for the Class Schedule:

- After logging in, click on Students – Registration – Add/Drop Classes;
- Enter your Alternate Pin, the registration PIN from your advisor.
- Either: enter CRNs (5-digit shortcuts for sections) on worksheet and press Submit,
- Or: choose a Subject area and click Course Search as described above,
- Choose a course to see section details, click the Select box of the section you wish to add, and click Register.
- If you select Add to Worksheet, you must click Submit Changes on the next screen.
- **To see all courses in a subject area: click Advanced Search, choose the Subject area,**
- You may have noticed that there is a number 1- at the beginning of each **subject area**. By adding that information to the search, it allows the courses to be selected at the same time. By holding down the shift key as each subject is highlighted (using the down arrow), a student can perform a section search of all courses at the same time instead of by each subject area individually.
- To search by **Course Attribute**, highlight all subject areas, then hold down the shift key for any attribute that begins with the major area you are looking for. A list of courses will be generated by the search, regardless of subject area.
- Click the Select box of the section you wish to add, and click Register. “Web Registered” will appear next to the course.

NOTE: You cannot drop your last class online. If you enter the wrong section as your first course, you must first add another course to drop the incorrect one. After you click Register, the Current Schedule screen displays your courses and any errors;

Scroll down to see any error messages, restrictions or courses requiring special approval and assistance to register:

“Instructor” or “Dean” – signature of instructor or dean is required to register for the course. Capacity overrides must be approved by the department chair.

“Time conflict with [CRN]” – indicates sections that conflict. The course can only be added with approval.

“Level restriction” – undergraduates cannot register for graduate courses. Check for an undergraduate cross-listed section.

“CORQ” – co-requisite restriction. Add the course and its co-requisite at the same time.

“PREQ” -- course has a prerequisite which must be completed before you can register for the course.

“DUPL” – you have already completed a course with the same number that is a Special Topics course or equivalent to the course.

If you plan to sign up for an internship or enroll in research courses, you will need to come to the office to enroll in those classes during Web-Assisted Registration. Internships require an approved form from the Office of Personal Career Development (OPCD) and Research credit requires submission of the UD Research Experience for Credit Registration Form, approved by the department chair and the professor. Variable-credit courses (listed on the schedule with a range of credit hours and a V in the course number) will default to the lowest number of credits. The Registrar’s Office can update your registration to the correct number of credits. After you have registered, **check your schedule** by clicking on Student Detail Schedule or Student Schedule by Day & Time on the Registration menu. Exit Banner Web and then exit the browser when you are finished.
